Social Security News

Q. I've had several different doctors and my bills are way over \$50 for the year, but not over \$50 from any doctor. If any one doctor's bill goes over \$50, can I file a claim on all the bills?

A. You can file a claim for payment now. The first \$50 (of medical bills in a year) is the "deductible," which you pay. It's immaterial whether the bills are from one or several doctors, or whether they are for different illnesses.
