NOTICE OF ELECTION IN SPECIAL SCHOOL TAX DISTRICT NO. 61.

Whereas, upon the written petition of more than one-third of the qualified voters of Local Tax District No. 61 known as the Fallston School District of Cleveland County, N. C., duly endorsed by the County Board of Education, it has been ascertained that the special tax, heretofore levied in said district and now being levied will be inadequate to maintain and support the school of said district, and whereas, said petition requests that an election shall be held in said district to ascertain the will of the people of said Local Tax District upon the question of increasing the special tax levy to an amount not exceeding fifty cents on the One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars valuation of property, real and personal.

Beginning at the bridge at M. J. Bakers, thence west straight to the County Line Road at the intersection of the Vance Royster road, thence South of Forest Champion's house to the Piedmont line near D. A. Beam's; thence with said Piedmont and Fallston line; thence with said Belwood and Fallston Line East to Buffalo Creek; thence south with said Buffalo Creek to Sam Bingham's line; thence with Sam Bingham's line back to Buffalo Creek and down Buffalo Creek to the beginning.

It is further ordered that Mrs. R. A. Luckey be and is hereby appointed registrar of said election, and B. O. Ross and John J. Blanton be and they are hereby appointed judges of said election. It is further ordered that in favor of increasing the special tax levy in said school district to an amount not exceeding fifty cents on the One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars valuation of property shall vote a ticket on which shall be printed or written the words "For Special Tax" and those who are opposed shall vote a ticket on which shall be printed or written the words "Against Special Tax".
