The two moons of Mars may indicate plenty of light during the night, but when you think of our old friend Jupiter with five moons, then you can imagine how much light you would have if you had five moons instead of one.

Jupiter had only four moons back in 1610. They were discovered by an old astronomer named Galileo, but it still remained for the modern astronomer and the modern telescope to search out and pick up many things that was impossible for the old astronomer to get.

There are many planets better off than the earth when it comes to moonlight. Saturn has eight satellites or moons and Venus is in itself one of the most brilliant bodies in the heavens, except the moon and sun.
