Forgetfulness to Tragedy
 (From Charlotte Observer)
 The major tragedy of the holidays
 occurred in an Oklahoma community
 in the burning of a schoolhouse in
 which children were gathered for
 Christmas tree festivities. It was a
 frame structure and was provided
 with but a single door. During the
 course of the evening a candle set
 fire to the tree and in the panic the
 door was jammed. Many children were
 burned to death and numbers of oth-
 ers were made orphans. It is too late
 to lament that the children were
 "lured into a veritable death trap—as
 if the one exit were not of sufficient
 menace, the windows were barred
 only too safely—but the occurrence
 may be kept in mind by people in oth-
 er communities against the coming
 of another holiday season, to the safe-
 guarding of children and parents
 from a like visitation. It was a ter-
 rible penalty for neglect visited up-
 on the people of the Oklahoma com-
 munity, the only consolation being
 that other people may remember. The
 much greater lesson in the tragedy
 of the Cleveland schoolhouse, in South
 Carolina, of which the people in all
 parts of the country must have read,
 was forgotten all too soon.
