### The Plaything Of Lightning Juan Accepts Village Homage.

### VANCE HEAVNER TO CONDUCT A MEETING AT TRIANGLE

### 'Twas a Hard Time for Liars

The party indexing the records at the court house find some interesting records. One found is a case held in the county court Friday, November 6, 1818, State vs Jonathan Coffey. The judgment of the court—Judge Henry Seawell—was that Coffey stand in the pillory for one hour; at the expiration of that time both ears to be cut off, entirely severed from the head, and be nailed to pillory until the setting of the sun. It was further adjudged that he be barred from ever testifying in court and that he pay a fine of \$10 and the costs.

It was not stated what the charge was against Coffey but it was, perhaps, perjury. Some one properly remarks that if such judgments were customary today that there might be a good many ear-less people around.

### FIGHTING ROOSTER KILLS MATCHMAKER IN THE PIT

Manila, May 19.—A rooster killed a man today at Porac, Pampanga, province.

The rooster, a fighting cock, had just vanquished a feathered adversary. Adentes Mercado, matchmaker, was sitting in the cockpit. The game bird turned on him and struck him in the abdomen with his gaffe, the razor like blade which is attached to the legs of fighting cocks.

Mercado died an hour later.
