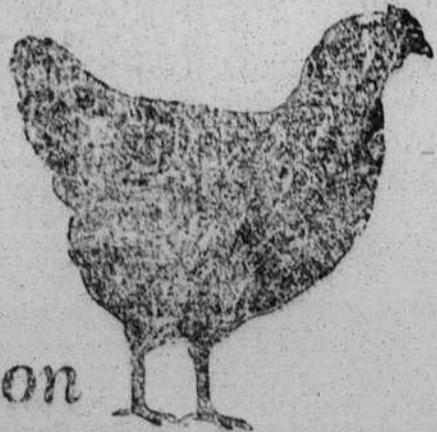

### Evolution Case Is No Joke, Bryan Declares

Is Beginning of End of Attacks on the Bible By School Teachers, Says The Commoner.

The test case in Tennessee, to determine the constitutionality of the state's law against the teaching of evolution in the public schools "is not a joke, but the beginning of the end of attacks upon the Bible by those teachers in the public schools who have been substituting the guesses of scientists for the word of God," William Jennings Bryan said in a formal statement in Chicago.

There are four sources of control of the public schools, Mr. Bryan, who will act as counsel for the state in Tennessee case, said. He termed them as the state legislature, second, boards of education acting under authority of the legislature, third, the teachers themselves, and 11,000 scientists.

Regarding legislative control, he said:

"Legislatures fix the death penalty for crime, and the form and extent of other punishments. Legislatures regulate marriage, descent of property care of children and all other matters between citizens. Why are our legislators not competent to decide what kind of schools are needed, the kind of requirements of teachers, and the kind of instruction that shall be given."

Boards of education act under authority of the legislature and finally of the people themselves he said. Concerning the control of scientists, he added:

"If the number of scientists is put at 11,000, it makes about one scientist for every 10,000 people.

A teacher, he asserted, "must respect the wishes of his employers on all subjects upon which the employees have a deep seated conviction. The same logic would suggest that a teacher receiving in pay dollars on which is stamped 'in God we trust' must not be permitted to teach the classroom that there is no God."

"Neither should he be allowed to accept employment in a Christian

community and teach that the Bible is not true. That is the Tennessee case.

"Evolution disputes the Bible record of man's creation and the logic of the evolutionist eliminates as false the miracles of the Bible, including the virgin birth and the bodily resurrection of Christ."

Christians, he declared, build their own colleges to teach Christianity, and he suggested that atheists and agnostics build their own schools to teach what they believe.

### Twenty Cars Sold At Auction For \$58.62

Los Angeles Police Department Sale Of Unclaimed Vehicles Attracts Low Bidders.

Automobiles were purchased for from \$1 to \$4 and motorcycles for 50 cents at a sale held in Los Angeles police department in disposing of unclaimed machines. The lowest price paid was 25 cents for a battered chassis of a popular make of car, while the high mark was reached when an anxious motorist bid \$10.50 for an antique motor-driven conveyance that was guaranteed to run.

In all, 20 cars were sold, a majority of which were of ancient model and some with romantic records. They brought in a total of \$58.62. The lowest price paid for a complete automobile was \$1. Motorcycles were sold at prices ranging from 50 cents to \$2.

Buyers were obliged to move the cars from the stockade and police department officials says most of them left at the end of tow ropes.

It's a Beauty Cream and For Use of Her Picture Mrs. Longworth Gets \$5,000.

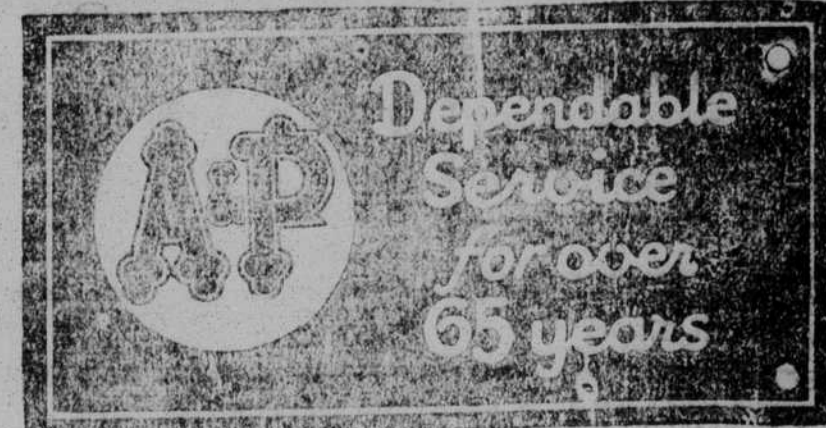

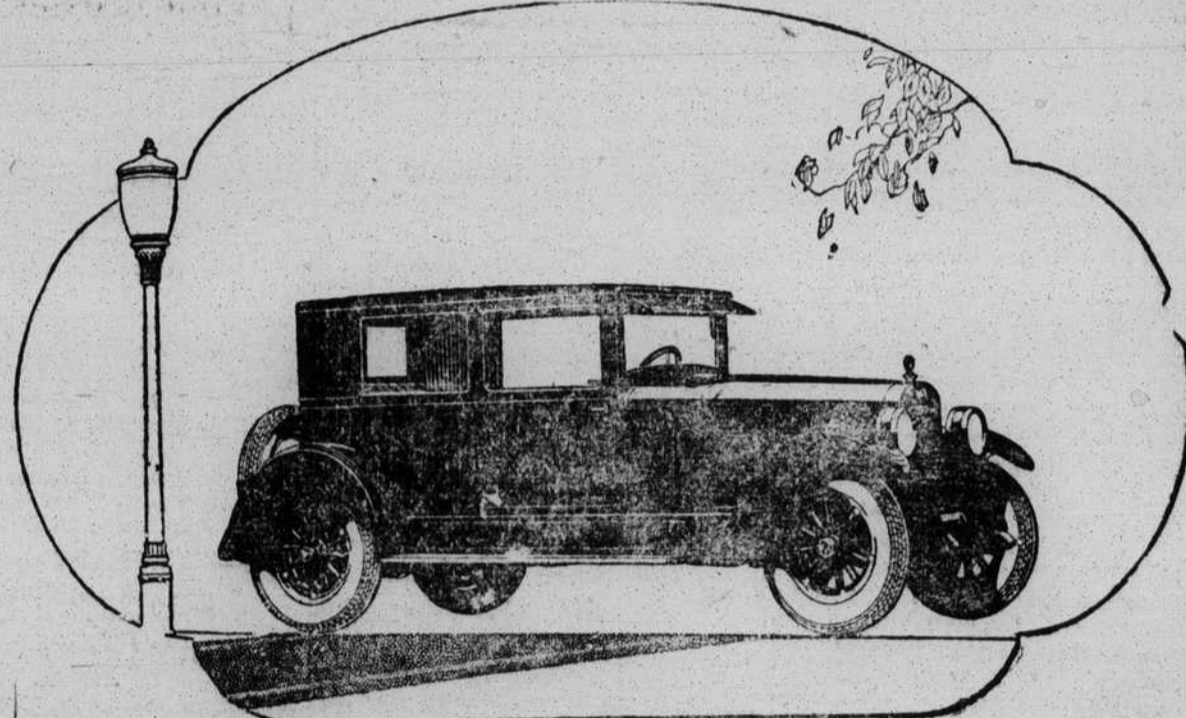
