### NEW YORK STATE TO VOTE ON LIGHT WINE AND BEER

Albany, May 20.—New York state with its population larger than that of any other commonwealth in the union, is to have an official referendum on prohibition. Voters of the states will ballot at the November election on the question of modifying the Volstead act to permit the manufacture and sale of light wines and beers, as the result of Governor Smith's approval of Karle-Jelkes referendum bill late today which previously had passed the assembly and senate.
