

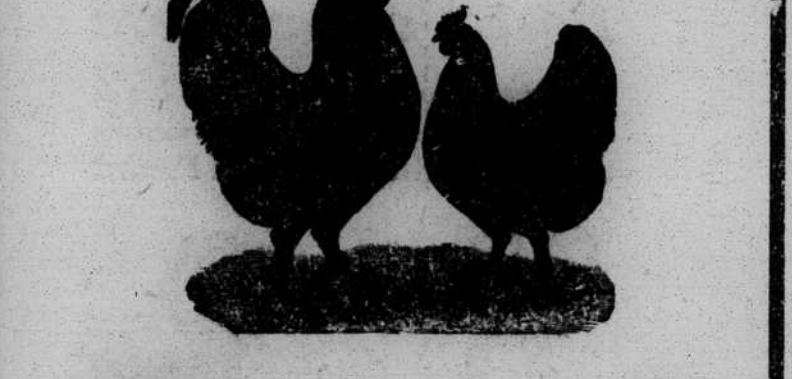
POULTRY FANCIERS TO HAVE BIG TREAT AT CLEVELAND COUNTY FAIR
