Judge Webb Makes Speech of Dedication. Clyde Hoey Presents Justice Portrait.

Rutherfordton, Nov. 3 .- Nearly 1,000 people attended the dedication of Rutherford county's new \$250,-000 courthouse here today. Attorney M. L. Edwards was in charge of the services. Special music by Mrs. Nell Padgett Norris of Forest City was a feature of the day.

Attorney Fred D. Hamrick introduced the speaker of the day, Judge James L. Webb, of Shelby, who delivered the dedicatory ad dress in a most able manner. He commended Rucherford for the

magnificent new temple of justice. After Judge Webb's address short and appropriate speeches were delivered by Solicitor J. W. Pless, Attorneys C. B. McBrayer and Clyde R. Hoey, of Shelby. All commended the county for its progress and the new court house.

An oil portrait of the late Judge M. H. Justice was presented the county by the Justice family to be hung in the court house room, Clyde R. Hoey made the speech of presentation in a pleasing manner. Rutherford county has had five courthouses built during her his-

tory, including the present one. In the early days of the county, during the close of the 18th century, court was had at different homes. Usually the - largest log , house in the community was the place for the trial of cases. The first court house that Rutherford county ever erected was located on Shepherd's creek, now Holland's creek, about two miles north of Rutherfordton. It was a log house and cost a few hundred dollars.

The second temple of justice was erected on what is now South Main street. In 1838 the third courthouse was erected on the lot where the Sun Printing office now is located. It was burned down the night of December 24, 1907.

Fourth in 1908
The fourth hall of justice for the county was built on the present square in 1908. It as of brick construction. The total cost was about \$47,000. The county commissioners who built it are all living. They are: C. M. Lynch, chairman, Joe M Glover and J. M. Miller.

In the early part of 1925 the county officials decided that the court house was too small, out-of date and dangerous. It had been condemned by various experts. It was sold in June 1925 for \$500. Contract was soon let for the construction of the present magnificent edifice which was recently completed at a total cost of \$260,-000 including furniture and fix-

There is no more attractive or commodious courthouse in the South, for a county the size of Rutherferd than one just completed. The county commissioners made a close study of the leading courthouses of this and adjoining states. It is two stories high, besides a large basement.

Senator Overman was re-elected vesterday by the voters of North Carolina by a majority of more than 100,000 over his Republican epponent.

Catawba's Delegate Married in Shelby

L. F. Klutz, Republican member of the house of representatives from Catawba county, who wen out over Gus Self, prominent Democrat by a majority of 121 votes, married Mrs Maggie Lou Cline Turner, widow of the late Charlie Turner of Cleveland county. Mr. Klutz is a native of Catawba being born in Maiden. Over 9,000 votes were cast in the Catawba county election on Tuesday, Mr. Self reeiving 4704 votes and Mr. Klutz 4825, according to returns published in the Hickory Daily Record.

Representative Klutz was educated at South Fork institute; Caawba college; Washington and Lee university, Valparaiso univerity, where he received the B. A. egree in 1910; and degree of Bach der of oratory in 1911; Trinity ollege law school 1912-13 and Wake Forest law school 1914.

In 1914 he was licensed to pracice law and became a member of he North Carolina bar association.




