Geer and Wilson, contractors of Rutherford-ton, had submitted the lowest bid for the Rutherford county part of the work and next to the lowest bid for the Polk county end. If the State highway commission, as it is thought possible, decides not to use as much sand on the Columbus end of the route, then Messrs.
