## Egg-Laying Match Keeps Hens Busy

(By International News Service.)

STORRS, Conn.—A new record seems to be in the training at the Connecticut state agricultural college here where hens from one end of the country to another are competing in an egg-laying contest of twelve months' duration. The record is being run by hens from Hollywood Poultry farm, Woodline, Washington. These hens, white Leghorns, had laid 2,399 eggs in a matter of forty-five weeks, and have to lay but 132 eggs in the remaining seven weeks to equal the contest record of 2,531 eggs, established by hens from C. T. Darby's chicken ranch at North Branch, N. J.

The hens from the state of Washington were laying almost 76 per cent at the end of the forty-fifth week. They and their hen-competitors in the contest had laid a total of 233,290 eggs in 45 weeks. There are 140 pens of ten birds each in the competition, and the average has been 1,666 eggs per bird. The

state egg laying contest is now in its sixteenth year.

Leading birds from Maine, Connecticut, Virginia, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, Ohio, Washington, Michigan, Indiana, New York, Missouri, New Jersey, California, Oregon, Pennsylvania, New York and Canada.
