Raleigh.—North Carolina has "approximately 5,000 children ranging from low grade morons to high-grade imbeciles trying to be educated in county and public schools of the state," Dr. W. H. Dixon, superintendent of Caswell training school says in an article in the October issue of Public Welfare Progress.
