

Special Plant Manufactures Stained Cathedral Windows

Washington.—Artistic ideals of the middle ages will be portrayed in the 183 great windows of the Washington Cathedral being erected on Mount St. Alban.

A special glass making plant for the production of the windows has been established near Philadelphia. Lawrence B. Saint, an American stained glass artist, is in charge. The ingredients employed in the manufacture are the same as those found in specimens of glass taken from notable windows of medieval cathedrals.

They are mixed with as much care as though a medical prescription was being compounded. The French system of grams and milligrams is used for measuring. Only 25 pounds of glass are made at a time.
