

Chicago.-For 10 years he has lived on 20 cents a day. Aaron Toma, 55, a railroad worker, told Leon Edelman, assistant to probate Judge Henry Horner, in making claim against the estate of his cousin. George Toma. Aaren seeks \$13,700 in savings he said he had intrusted to his cousin.
