Black Walnuts.
 The Southern Field.
 Growing black walnut trees for the wood and for the nuts may be made a profitable enterprise on farms and in forests in most parts of the South.

Black walnut is one of the highest priced of all American woods and is constantly increasing in value, due to the growing demand for its use in making fine furniture, piano cases, radio cabinets, gun stocks, etc.

It takes half a century for a walnut tree to grow to large sawmill size, but it will begin to bear nuts in from 8 to 10 years, the crop increasing as the tree grows in size. The hulled nuts are readily salable at no less than 75 cents a bushel. Improved varieties that crack easily, and from which the meat can be taken out in large pieces, are now available for planting.

Among the new varieties the Thomas ranks very high. The Stabler and Ohio are also good varieties. In every locality in which they will do well, including all of the Piedmont and Mountain sections of the south and much of the coastal plain area, walnuts should be included in every planting of forest.

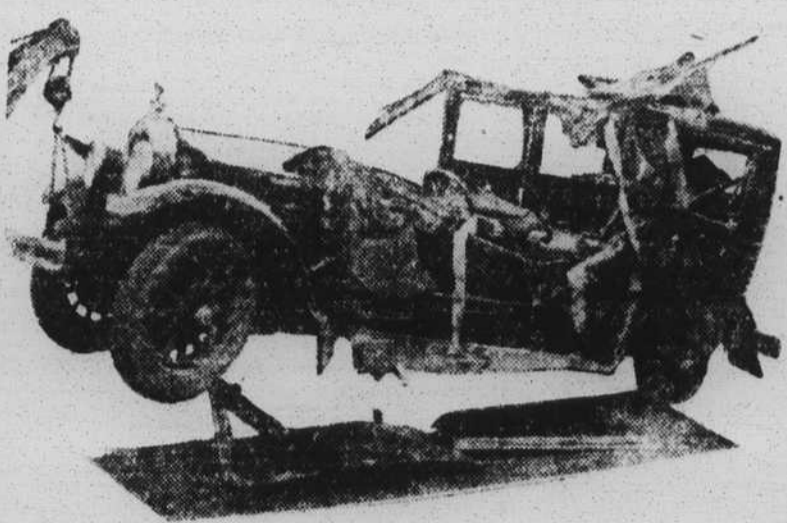
