Examine Regularly. It's a good plan to examine orchards regularly in fall and early in spring for signs of mouse injury. Mouse injury in orchards may be prevented in four ways: Removing cover around trees; treating trees with washes to repel mice; enclosing trees with mechanical protectors; and killing the rodents. Poison-bait stations are probably the best way of controlling mice in orchards, according to the Biological Survey of the United States department of agriculture.

Prices on the tobacco markets of Columbus county averaged about four cents a pound above the price received last season and farmers expressed satisfaction at the outcome. Walter Parkson of Brighton, Eng. skated 50 miles on roller skates in 7 hours and 19 minutes.
