## Hampton Treated Shamefully At Gilbert Town

After the night at Cane Creek, and the retreat of McDowell over the Mountains, Colonel Ferguson thought the war was virtually ended. So when William Green, rode up with a troop of cavalry and tendered his and their services for the defense of the Kings cause, the British commander thanked them for their loyalty; but declined their acceptance for the reason that the country was subdivided, and everything was quiet.

While this state of affairs existed, Jonathan Hampton, a crippled patriot, was living in the vicinity of Gilbert Town. Young Hampton, a son of Colonel Andrew Hampton, was reported to Colonel Ferguson as being one who held the Kings authority in great contempt for he had accepted a commission of justice of the peace from the rebel government in North Carolina and had actually performed a marriage ceremony. This was a high crime from a British and Tory viewpoint, and so a party of some four or five hundred soldiers was dispatched under Major Plummer, and Major Lee to apprehend Squire Hampton, and possibly

entrap his father at the same time. However, Colonel Hampton had left to join McDowell's forces before the British troops arrived but his son was found at home and captured by the enemy.

Jonathan Hampton was shamefully treated by a portion of his captors. The Tories cursed him soundly for a d-d rebel, and Major Lee knocked him down and tried to ride on him, but the horse jumped over his body without doing him any harm. Hampton and his wife's brother, Jacob Hyder were made prisoners, and those who had the former in charge swore they would hang him on the spot. To make good their threat they began to uncoil a bed to procure a rope when Mrs. Hampton ran to Major Plummer to get him to put a stop to the unjust proceedings. Plummer was a more humane officer than Major Lee and he at once put a stop to the threatened execution.

Some of the Tories were very much disappointed at not being allowed to hang Hampton. They thirsted for his blood, and declared in his presence that Ferguson would put to death such a notorious rebel. The moment he laid eyes on him, but this bitter talk did not in any way influence the decisions of Major Plummer. That officer informed Hampton if he would give security for his appearance for next day at Gilbert Town, he might remain at home over night. After several Tories had declined to do the captured patriot this favor, Major Plummer

himself generously offered to be his security. According to promise, Jonathan Hampton went to Gilbert Town the next day and presented himself to Colonel Ferguson, who proceeded to examine his case. While this work was being done, Major Dunlap came in. That officer was still on crutches as a result of being wounded at Cane Creek, and he, like Major Lee, was extremely bitter in his attitude towards the rebels. Dunlap did his best to influence Ferguson to have Hampton executed, but the British commander pardoned the patriot captive and allowed him to return home.

Shortly after this Colonel Ferguson began the march toward Kings Mountain. He evidently discovered that the patriots from over the mountains were going to give him trouble, so he desired to get closer to Lord Charles, who had just come to Charlotte.

Some two weeks hence I expect to give an account of the gathering of the clans to fight Ferguson.
