\$86,000 Paid To Bank Depositors

Forest City, May 22.—Ten per cent dividend checks, amounting to approximately \$86,000, was mailed to depositors of the closed Farmers Bank and Trust company today by Dr. John D. Biggs, liquidating agent.

The Farmers Bank and Trust company closed February 4, 1930 and this is the first payment to depositors of the bank. Dr. Biggs states that he hopes to be able to pay another dividend in the fall, but that he cannot make any definite promise to this effect.

Rifle Range At Piedmont Camp
To Be Provided This Summer By Gastonia Rotary Club. Other Equipment.
(Special to The Star.)
Gastonia, May 23.—The Gastonia Rotary club in meeting voted funds for the building of a rifle marksmanship range at the Piedmont Boy Scout camp at Lake Lanier, near Tryon.

The range will include shelter and equipment and will make it possible for hundreds of boys to strive for the merit badge in rifle marksmanship under safe conditions. The range will be operated under the supervision of Scout Executive R. M. Schiele who is a range officer of the National Rifle Association.

For the past five or more years, the Gastonia Rotary club have donated equipment to the Piedmont Boy Scout camp, having furnished the camp with a 25 foot war canoe, a patrol cabin, a safety crib in which boys who can not swim may enjoy the water in perfect safety and to learn to swim, a life saving patrol boat and a large raft and diving tower.

Hundreds of boys of the Piedmont area attend the scout camp at Lake Lanier each summer. From 800 to 1,000 Boy Scouts are expected to attend the camp this summer.
