State Turns Down Bid For 18,500 Shoes

Awards Contract For 10 Tons Dynamite, Battery Contract Waits On Inspection.

The State Division of Purchase and Contract has awarded a contract for 10 tons of dynamite, tentatively awarded a contract for 1,500 storage batteries, and rejected all bids for 18,600 pairs of shoes, A. S. Brower, director stated Saturday

in Raleigh. The dynamite contract was awarded to the Mill Power Supply company of Charlotte, at \$280 a ton. The storage battery contract was tentatively awarded to the Odell Hardware company of Greensboro. A sample of the battery was not submitted, however, and the low bidder will be required to submit it for inspection before the contract is closed.

Bids on 18,000 pairs of shoes for prisoners, and 600 pairs of shoes for boys were rejected, as unsatisfactory. New bids will be received August 11 based on specifications to be announced by the division later.

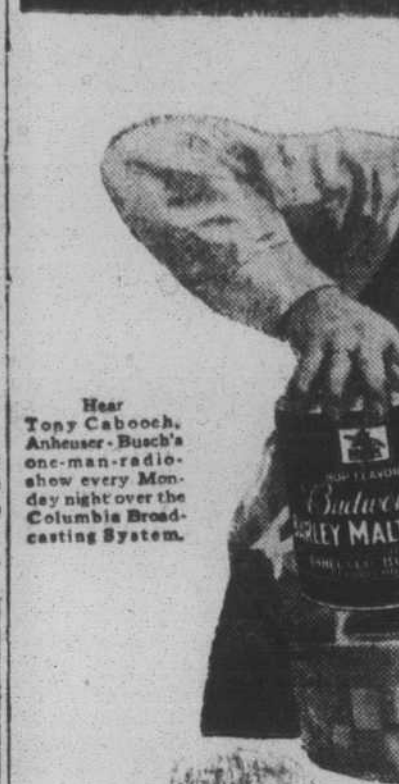
