Millions May Starve Result China Flood

Ten Million Driven From Their Homes. 250,000 Refugees As Result Of Flood.

Washington, Aug. 18.—A rapid spread of death and destitution by floods on the Yangtze river in China was reported to the state department today by the American legation at Peiping. Minister Johnson at Peiping said it was estimated that 31,000,000 persons were seriously affected by the flood which had driven possibly 10,000,000 from their homes. The American consulate at Hankow estimated the drowned at "a few thousands" and damage to the cotton crop at more than \$35,000,000.

The three provinces principally affected were Hunan, Hupen, and Kiangsi. Refugees in the larger cities total 220,000.

While there was no acute shortage of food, millions of persons were said to have lost all their possessions and were approaching the point where they could not buy food or shelter.

Health conditions in Hankow were threatened by the flooding of sanitary works, the reports said.

Duke Freshmen To Report Sept. 8th

Placement Tests to be Held and Fresh to Become Acquainted With Campus.

Durham, Aug. 19.—Freshmen of Duke university will get an early start on their academic careers next month by reporting a week before upperclassmen for a special orientation program. The dormitories will be opened for the newcomers on September 8 and the freshmen

week program will get underway the following day.

Programs will be carried out simultaneously on the west campus and the woman's college campus. The men's program will open in the morning and the women's in the afternoon. The first men's assembly will be at 9 o'clock in Page auditorium, and the women will meet for the first time at 2:30 o'clock in their own auditorium.

Psychological and placement tests, library tours, photographing, physical examinations, matriculation, and assemblies will comprise the business part of entering the

university. Addresses of welcome and introduction of administration, faculty, and student leaders will feature the assemblies. President W. P. Few, Dr. R. L. Flowers, Dean W. H. Wannamaker and Dean Altee M. Baldwin will be among those welcoming the students and giving them suggestions regarding their debut as college men and women.

Recreational features of the program will include informal socials, a faculty-student open house at the Union, moving pictures, tennis and swimming.

Freshman classes will begin on Monday, September 14.
