The mule what Dide last week was not no account, as she was old and could not pull, and also send a pair of shoes size a D/8 with straps and don't send nothing but slippers. Also about 3 pounds of coffee to go with the sugar. The shoes

is for my wife, Lucie.

I think we will make about 25 bale of cotton this year instead of 12 Bale like last year. and also send 2 bucket of lard with a rain-bow on it, and our cotton has blossoms All over it, and the New Ground is better than the Big Field. Also send \$4 Dollars in money as our big Meeting starts Sunday and we will hafter feed the preacher.

Please send Everything at Once when your truck Comes down, and leave them at Mr. Smith's store, and also send some stuff for the Old lady and Miss in the chicken house. Some of Our Cotton is up to my Nake, also send a sack of Salt for us and the Mules and Send the \$4 Dollars by All means.
