holidays with their parents.

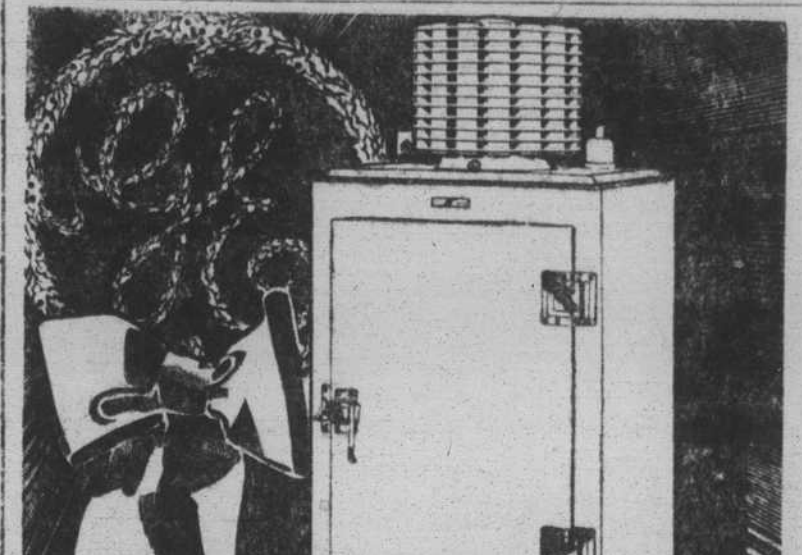
