## Telegraph Companies Begin New "Timed Wire" Service For Patrons

Extensive preparations had been completed and all was in readiness last night for the inauguration today of the new timed wire service separately and jointly by the Western Union and Postal Telegraph companies.

Both companies yesterday distributed to all patrons affected a joint "Telegraph Timed Wire Directory" which lists by states and cities all of the nearly 10,000 business offices in all parts of the country having the telegraph printers of Western Union or Postal or both.

Major Western Union and Postal offices have been connected by trunk lines in all cities and towns where such lines will be necessary in the exchange of communications between exclusive patrons of either of the telegraph companies.

All mechanical changes and instructions to forces necessary for

the instant handling of timed wire service messages had been completed last night, and the thousands of machines involved in the service in telegraph offices throughout the country all stood ready to handle the business.

As the first business offices began sending their lengthy communications by the new service today, these machines in telegraph main offices began their process of instantaneously reproducing, in combinations of perforations of tape, the messages written on machines in their offices by patrons.

The tapes were then fed into high speed multiplex telegraph instruments, which in turn transmitted the messages instantly to the distant cities addressed. There the perforated tapes were fed into transmitters connected with the telegraph printers of the addressees, where the message is received in words.

The charge for the new service is based on the number of minutes the patron actually operates his telegraph printer in sending the message. For a three minute period the charge is twice the price of a ten word telegram.

For each minute over three, one-third of the initial rate is charged. A capable operator can send as many as sixty words a minute, so whenever a business man with a telegraph printer in his office wishes to send a lengthy message to a correspondent with a printer in his office, Timed wire service offers a real saving. The business man with a short message, however, will send the message over his printer as usual as a fast telegram day, or other type of short message.
