MANUFACTURERS ASK FOR LOANS

Make Mistake of Applying To Congressmen Instead of Agriculture Secretary.

Cigarette Users Pay Biggest Tax

Average Smoker Pays About \$20 Year Tax For Privilege Of Smoking.

Washington.—Do you smoke cigarettes? Or perhaps you have a friend who does, in which case you may now be able to tell him a few things he doesn't know about cigarettes.

Estimates of the number of American cigarette smokers run as high as 35,000,000, but Julius Parker, New York lawyer who represented the tobacco industry at the tax hearings of the House Ways and Means Committee, undertook to speak for an estimated 20,000,000 persons who, he guessed would average about a package a day.

It is provided further "that the secretary of agriculture shall give preference in making such loans or advances to farmers who suffered from crop failures in 1931. Such advances or loans shall be made upon such terms and conditions and subject to such regulations as the secretary of agriculture shall prescribe."

"A first lien on all crops growing, or to be planted and grown, shall, in the discretion of the Secretary of agriculture, be deemed sufficient security for such loan or advance. All such loans or advances shall be made through such agencies as the secretary of agriculture may designate, and in such amounts as such agencies, with the approval of the secretary of agriculture may determine.

cents, according to Parker, who said the manufacturers' profit was not in excess of 1 1/2 cents a package—20 per cent of the entire "profit" as compared with 80 per cent taken by the treasury.

All popular brands of cigarettes use some Turkish tobacco and all items subject to duties, Parker said. Cigarette consumption was increasing at the rate of about 10 per cent a year up to and through 1929 but depression and state sales taxes slowed up the rate of increase substantially in 1930 and business remained about the same in the first half of 1931.
