Ossining, N. Y .- Walter Bannigan, repentant, came back to Sing Sing this week after 22 years of stolen liberty. He announced had "got religion" and wanted to cleanse his soul by serving the remainder of a term of 14 years.

Warden Lewis E. Lawes met Bannigan at the gates and installed him in a new cell. He said he might

Bannigan at the age of 25, was sentenced in 1908 for assault and blackmail. One night after he had served two years he, "Big Bill" Green, a notorious desperado, and three others overpowered two keepers and shinned over a wall to free-

The others were recaptured. Bannigan disappeared without s trace. He spent most of that time in Metropolitan area of New York, he revealed today, and worked for a time as a paint maker. One night he wandered into Boland's Mission on W. 42nd street and that was the
