State Highway Commission is Planning to Build Hard-Surface On Scenic Route. Raleigh, N. C.—At last North Carolina will have a state highway to the top of the tallest mountain, Mount Mitchell, if the State Highway commission completes plans now under contemplation.

At its meeting here last week, the Highway commission authorized a survey for a new highway that will extend to within 1700 yards of the tower on the summit. This new survey will start at Buswick on route 104, that connects with route 69 at Micaville and with route 10 a few miles west of Marion.
