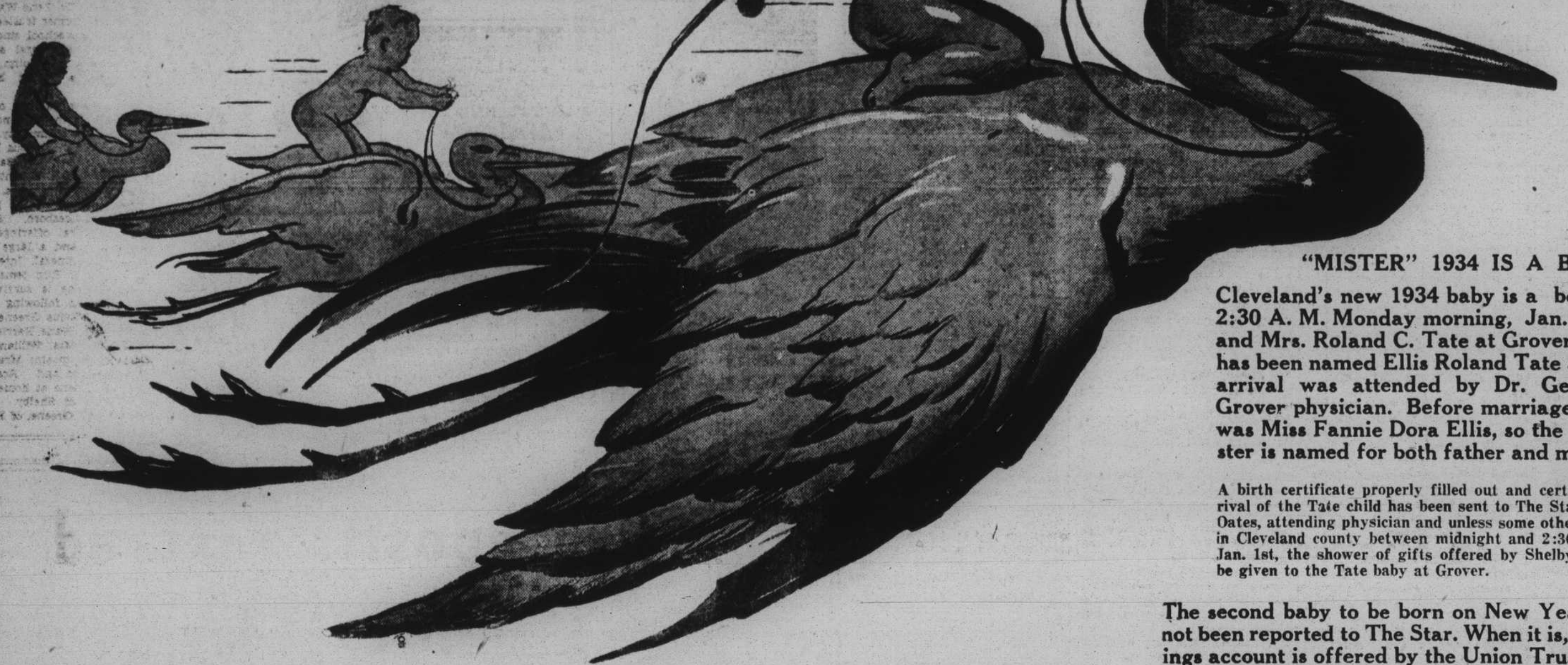


# GROVER YOUNGSTER IS "MISTER" 1934 GETS GIFT SHOWERS
