HERE'S WHAT YOU WILL SEE ON A TRIP AROUND THE 1934 WORLD'S FAIR GROUNDS

ART INSTITUTE — on Michigan Boulevard near the north entrance of the Exposition. Will contain the official Century of Progress Art Exhibit—gathered from all parts of the world.

FIELD MUSEUM — One of the world's largest and most interesting museums of natural history.

SHEDD AQUARIUM — Overlooking Lake, adjoining Exposition grounds. Marvelous collection of marine life.

SOLDIERS' FIELD — Chicago's immense stadium, seating 120 thousand people. Adjoins Exposition grounds.

SEARS ROEBUCK BUILDING — great exhibition of the mail-order business.

CZECHO-SLOVAKIAN PAVILION, ITALIAN PAVILION, JAPANESE PAVILION — all contain interesting exhibits of history, scenery, and products of these nations.

SKY RIDE — towers 628 feet high, with big safe observation cars making a two thousand foot trip between mainland and Northerly Island. Observation platform at top of towers.

LAMA TEMPLE — the famous golden temple of Jehol, built in China and transported to Chicago for the Exposition.

SWISS VILLAGE — reproduction of old Bern, Switzerland.

HALL OF SCIENCE — largest exhibit building with nine acres of floor space. Thousands of scientific marvels.

GENERAL EXHIBITS BUILDINGS — five modernistic towers and main hall, with many industrial exhibits.

SINCLAIR EXHIBIT — pre-historic monsters move and battle as they did a million years ago!

CHRISTIAN SCIENCE MONITOR BUILDING.

FIRESTONE BUILDING — a complete manufacturing unit showing the making of tires.

TEXAS CO. THERMOMETER — a thermometer 220 feet high, which shows the temperature in colored Neon tubes.

INFANT INCUBATOR — see live babies given chance for life in amazing incubators!

FOREIGN VILLAGES — around-the-world, at home! Native costumes, dances, games, shops and eating places. They include: SPANISH, ITALIAN, BELGIAN, OLD ENGLISH, GERMAN, BLACK FOREST, TUNISIAN, EARLY AMERICAN.

MIDGET VILLAGE — home of the Lilliputians.

FORT DEARBORN — exact reproduction of old Fort Dearborn, the site of Chicago one hundred years ago.

LINCOLN GROUP — Lincoln's birthplace, Rutledge Tavern, other historic buildings.

HOME AND INDUSTRIAL ARTS GROUP — includes: Masonite House, Stransteel House, Armco-Ferro Enamel House, General Houses Inc. House, Lumber House, Brick House, Southern Cypress House — also separate buildings for Kohler Company, Crane Company, and Owens-Illinois Building.

HOME PLANNING HALL — large home exhibit building.

FORD BUILDING — an immense modernistic building on ten acres of ground, housing Ford's historic exhibit.

MAYAN GROUP — huge reconstruction of one of the grandest of the Mayan ruins.

GENERAL MOTORS BUILDING — Chevrolets completely assembled while you wait.

AMPHIBIAN LANDING FIELD — for air transportation to and from the Fair grounds.

CHRYSLER BUILDING — moving picture theatre, quarter mile test track in operation.

WINGS OF A CENTURY — pageant of transportation. Largest collection of historic vehicles ever assembled.

TRAVEL AND TRANSPORTATION BUILDING — huge exhibit of every kind of transportation, bus, rail and air.

POULTRY SHOW — hundreds of small buildings for international egg-laying contests.

ADLER PLANETARIUM — marvelous exhibition of the stars and planets in motion, with interesting lecture.

AGRICULTURAL GROUP — complete exhibition of farm science, production and distribution.

FEDERAL BUILDING — dramatic showing of army, navy, marine, and other federal departments.

STATES GROUP — visit your own home state exhibit.

SOCIAL SCIENCE BUILDING — exhibits of progress in education and social science, war on ignorance, poverty, crime.

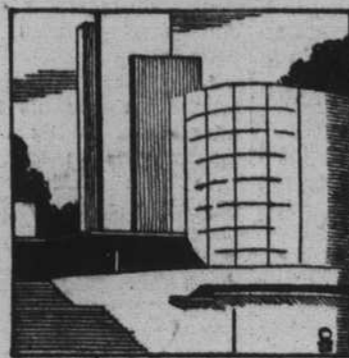
ELECTRICAL GROUP — one of the most fascinating exhibition buildings, showing all phases of electrical science.

ENCHANTED ISLAND — children's playground, fantastic attractions, interesting rides. Children may be left in safe care.

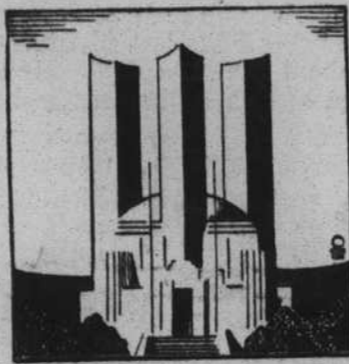
HORTICULTURAL BUILDING — permanent flower show.

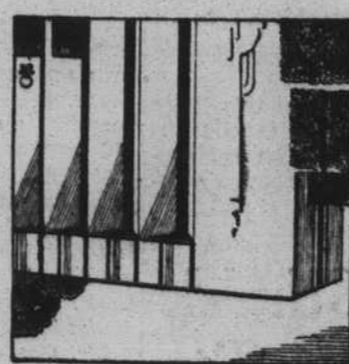
