Italian Legion Pushing Forward To Haile's Capital
13th Anniversary Is Celebrated
Selassie Prepares Celebration Of Victory Of Previous Years On Nov. 3.

Mussolini's legions celebrating the 13th anniversary of fascist rule in Italy, pushed forward into the Ethiopian interior on northern and southern fronts.

Thirteen years ago Il Duce led his black-shirted fascists into power with the cry, "On to Rome." Today the fascists shouted "On to Harar."

March On Makale. On the northern front new columns marched on Makale, strategic mountain pass and gateway to the interior. To the east advancing the south out of Adigrat was the main army or left column.

To the west the right column gave protection against any flanking maneuver by Ethiopians sweeping out of the mountains.

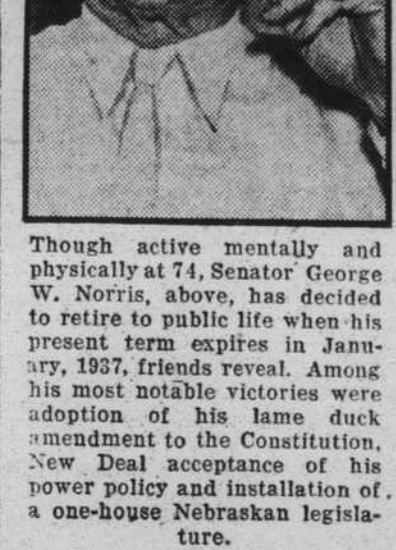
In the south the army was still hampered by rains but, divided into three columns, was advancing on a widespread front.

In Adis Ababa the Ethiopians were unprepared over the new Italian advances. Into the public squares, however, were being moved anti-aircraft guns.

Haile Celebrates. To stir enthusiasm among his warriors, Haile Selassie was preparing a celebration of his own today, the anniversary of Emperor Menelik's slaughter of the Italians at Adwa, November 3.

6,025 Autos And Trucks Licenses In Cleveland Now
Increase Of 450 Over A Year; Big Increase In The State Since October 1 Last Year.

RALEIGH, Oct. 28.—Motor vehicles registered in North Carolina during the first nine months of the present calendar year reached 470,297 on October 1, or 32,078 more than the 439,200 registered one year ago and within 813 of the 471,092 registered for the entire 12 months of last year.

The figures show 380,780 automobiles, 88,254 trucks and trailers and 1,245 motorcycles. Non-residents own 2,250 automobiles and 1,175 trucks.

Guilford leads with 24,075 cars and 4,100 trucks, Mecklenburg coming second with 21,225 cars and 3,800 trucks.

Cleveland county had 6,075 cars and 950 trucks as of October 1, as compared with 5,700 cars and 875 trucks a year before and 5,750 cars and 825 trucks three months before.

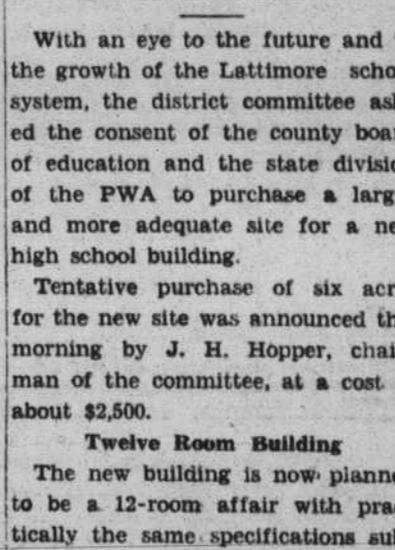
