

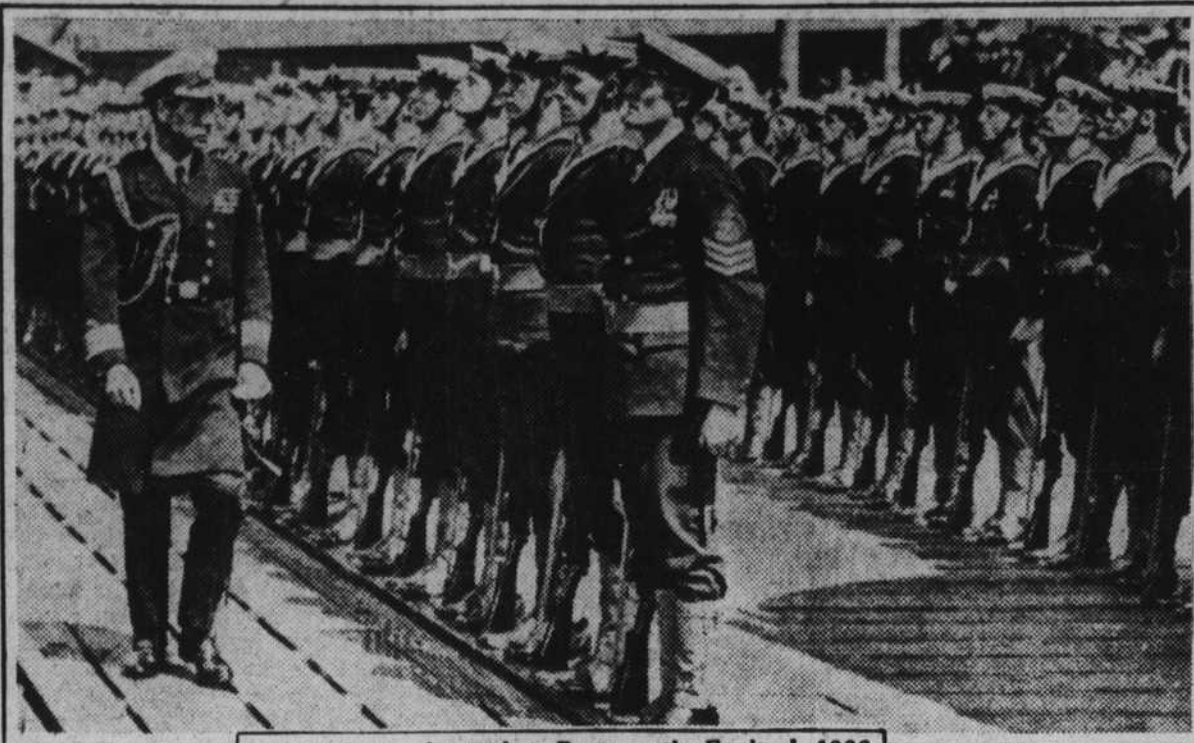

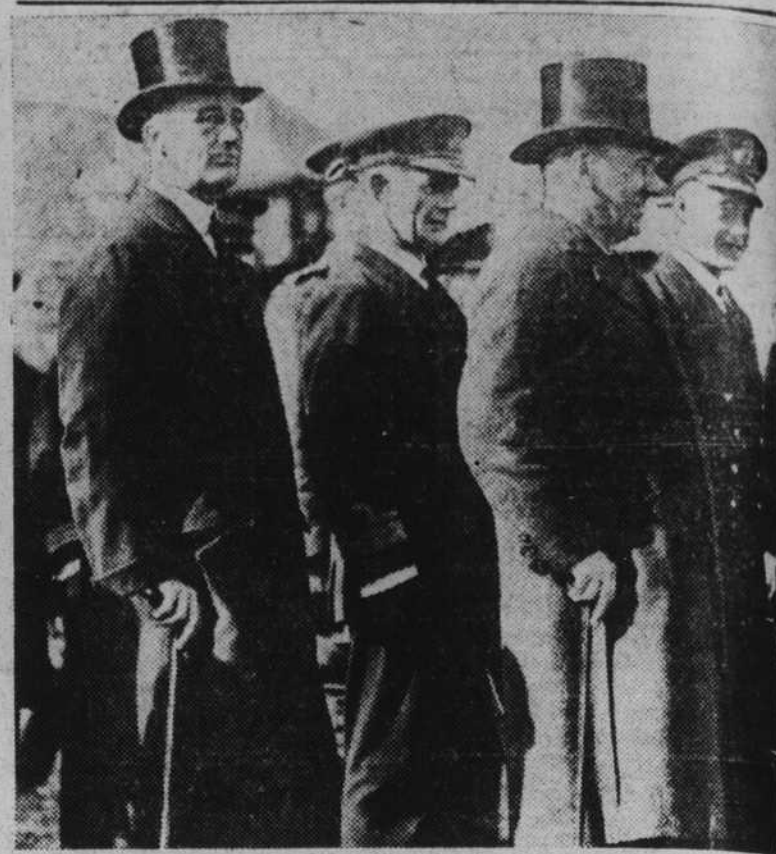
He was 33 years old here.

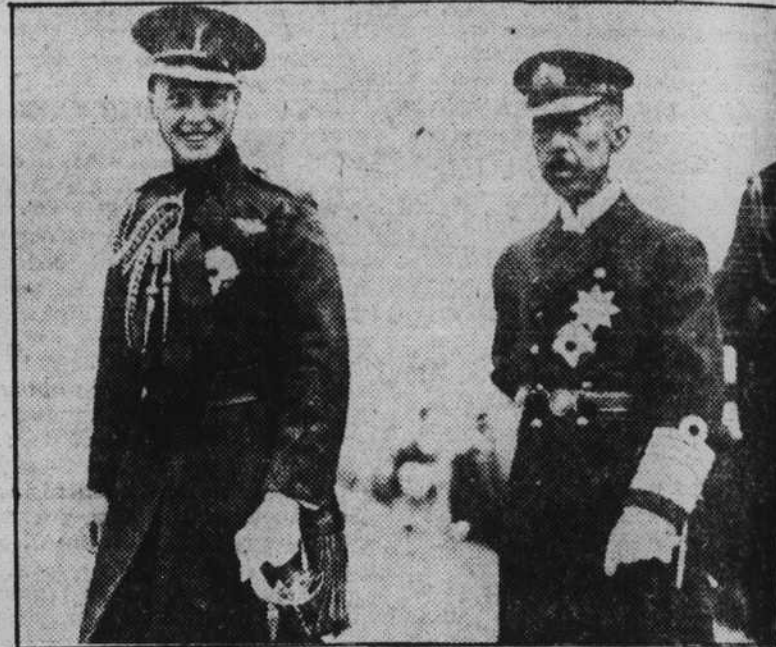

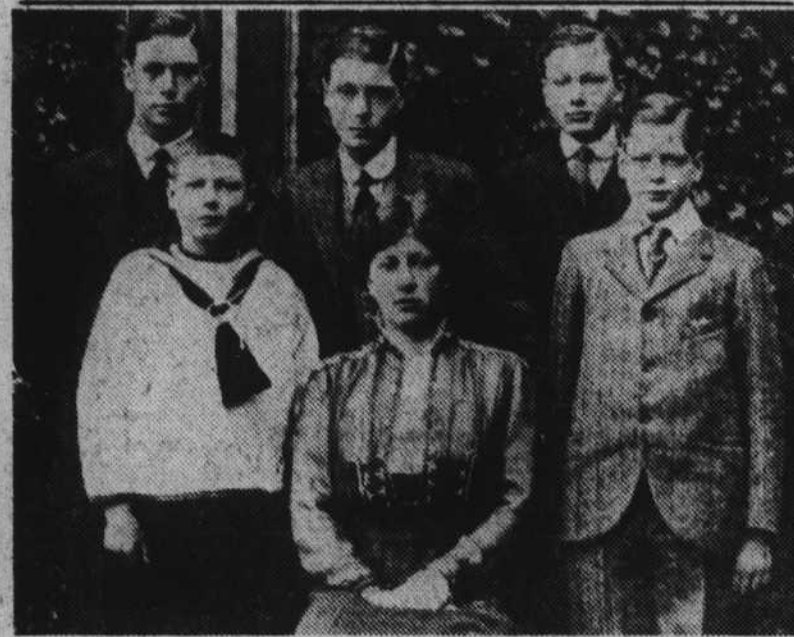

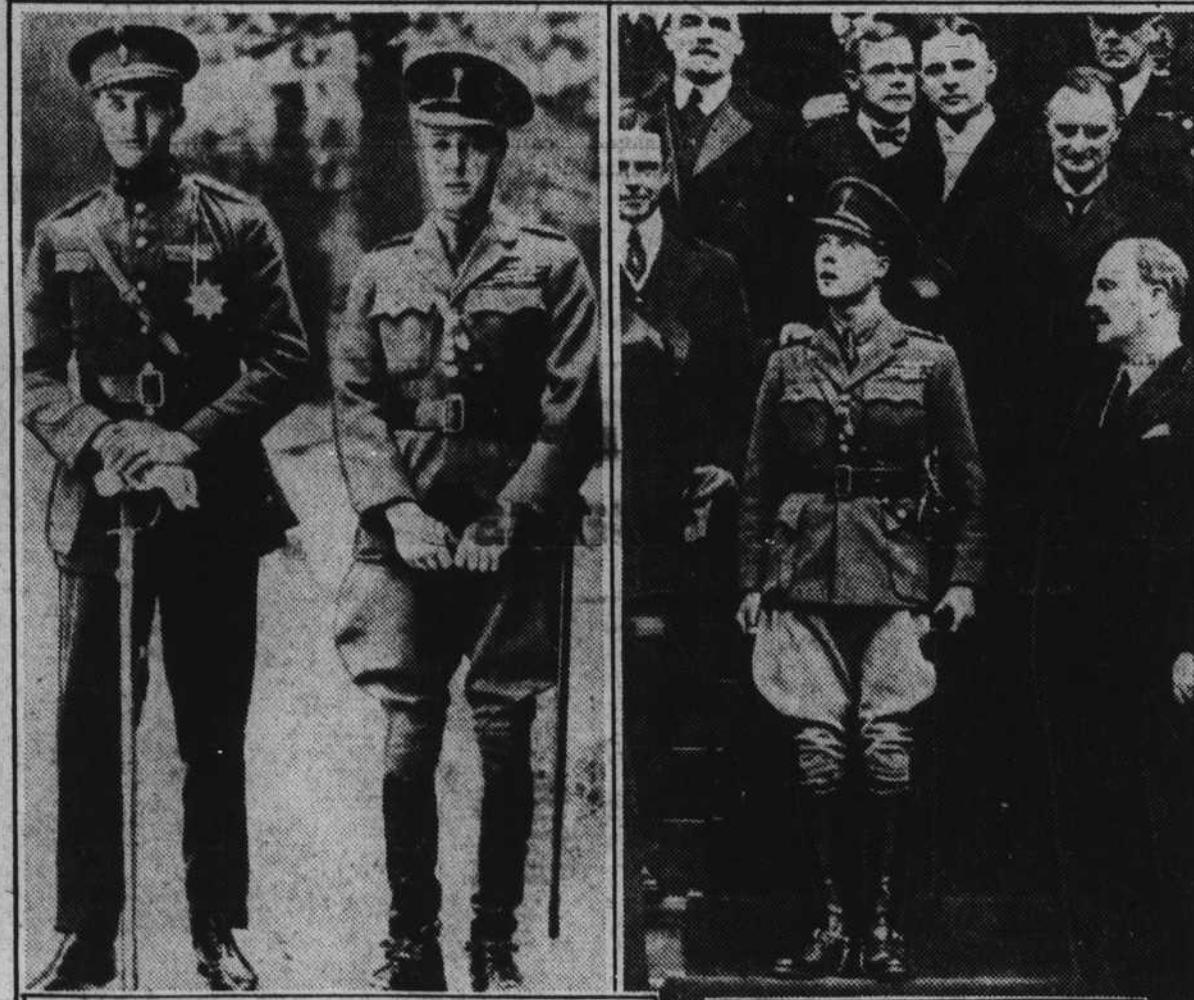
