Trailer Park, Marina And Aircraft Storage Owners

The 1971 General Assembly passed a law governing operators and/or owners of trailer parks, marinas and aircraft storage facilities in North Carolina.

The law in G.S. 105-316 of the North Carolina Machinery Act of 1971 reads as follows:

The owner of such park, marina or aircraft storage shall report to the county tax supervisor on or before January 15 of each year the name of the owner and a description of such trailers, boats or aircraft renting space in such park, marina or aircraft storage facility.
