To achieve certification, Jim Brown of Southport and S.R. "Buddy" Rudd of Yaupon Beach completed a series of speech projects in Toastmasters' basic international communications and leadership program. The self-paced program heips participants improve their speaking and leadership skills in a club environment. In addition to basic techniques of public speaking, they learn to offer constructive evaluations of others' efforts, to listen more effectively and to serve as club leaders.

"I think Toastmasters gives each person confidence in themselves to be able to communicate in front of a group or one-to-one," said Brown, who is president of the Brunswick Toastmasters. "Everyone could benefit from Toastmasters", regardless of what field they're in.

'With all the miscommunication there is, it's surprising how much we still accomplish."

He and Rudd received their certificates at a recent club meeting. They are now working on advanced speech projects in specialties of their choice.

Lions Hear Literacy Effort, Needs

Twelve tutors trained by the Brunswick County Literacy Council are helping to teach more than 3,000 non-reading adults in the county how to read, Council Chairman George Clementson told members of the Shallotte Lions Club at an Aug. 14 meeting at the Seafood Barn in Holden Beach.

The local council, formed in 1981 by volunteers working in conjunction with Brunswick Technical College, is part of a nationwide movement to combat illiteracy, he said.

Clementson stunned the Lions, said Secretary Leonard C. Ferguson, with figures for illiteracy across the nation: 800,000 citizens considered functional non-readers, unable to read well enough to handle day-by-day situations such as obtaining a

driver's license and shopping for

The national illiteracy rate is approximately 10 percent of the present popultaion, but is increasing at the rate of 2.5 million per year.

It is estimated, added Clementson, that 75 percent of all persons now unemployed are functional illiterates and that there is a direct relationship between illiteracy and unemploy-
