Agencies Provided Minimum Of \$186,390 In County Services

While it's sometimes hard to calculate the cost of providing services to a particular client or group of clients, area United Way agencies have tried to do just that.

Their report, released last week by United Way "loaned executive" Joe Bryant, is an attempt to show the level of spending by member agencies in delivering services to Brunswick County residents. That question was raised by campaign volunteers at a recent drive luncheon as information requested frequently by potential donors

At a minimum, the agencies spent \$186,390 in serving 14,377 Brunswick County clients. In some instances, the services were delivered at satellite sites within the county; in other cases, clients traveled to Wilmington for assistance.

The American Red Cross served at least 505 people during its most recently-documented 12-month period. It spent an estimated \$51,600 offering first aid, water safety and other classes.

Brunswick County residents used more blood than they donated to the bloodmobile program. At Brunswick Hospital alone, 636 units of blood were used, said Bryant.

Eleven clients were served by the Children's Home Society, at a cost of \$71,590, or \$6,500 per client.

Other agencies report the following Brunswick County-related expenses: Volunteer & Information Center 8,895 clients at a cost of \$41,907; Child Development Center, five children at a cost of \$28,930, or average cost of \$5,786 each; Elderhaus, one client, \$4,420; Information & Referral (Wilmington), 264 clients, \$10,033; New Hanover Workshop for the mentally retarded and/or physically handicapped adults, \$385 per person per month: specific YWCA programs, 201 clients, \$29,000; Salvation Army, 378, \$41,580; Cape Fear Substance Abuse, 2,072 through several pro-grams, including schools, \$32,000.

Some agencies said their costs varied, depending upon the service rendered. Family Services, whose help ranges from credit counseling to

Travelers Aid, served 169 clients. The cost varied depending upon the sliding scale fee paid and the number of sessions attended. Hospice, which served 240 terminally ill patients and their families in Brunswick County. said the cost depended on the degree of need and the length of time the family received assistance. All these agencies are scheduled to

receive allocations again in 1986-87, along with several new programs.

The Cape Fear Area United Way has proposed contributions \$1.51 They wold be granted in three broad categories: recreation and social development services, services to strengthen family and individual life and community ser-

Next year's allocations are proposed as follows:

Recreation/Social Development: Boy Scouts, \$59,000; Brigade Boys Club, \$89,500; Community Boys Club, \$74,000; Girl Scouts, \$30,000; Girls Club, \$80,100; YMCA, \$46,000; YWCA, \$49,657.

 Family/Individual Life: Child Development Center, \$47,500; Family Service, \$124,500; Hospice, \$25,100; Cape Fear Substance Abuse Center, \$52,320; New Hanover Workshop, \$13,000: Salvation Army, \$70,500; Senior Aide Program, \$22,000; Elderhaus, \$16,500; Senior Citizens of Pender County, \$17,800; Domestic Violence Shelter & Services, \$1,820; Cued Speech of Wilmington, \$1,190: Families in Crisis, \$1,303.

 Community Services: Woodlot Program, \$3,500; Brunswick County Volunteer and Information, \$43,583; American Red Cross, \$106,203; Cape Fear Area United Way, \$208,000; Stepping Stone Manor, \$21,000; Information and Referral, \$25,944; state and national programs, \$66,440; Food Bank of the Lower Cape Fear, \$5,000.

State employees are also expected to designate another \$6,000 to non-United Way agencies, while another \$30,000 in contributions will go to health agencies. United Way will allow \$96,640 for uncollectable pledges and a \$75,500 reserve for
