# Coastline Wants Gleanings From Spring Housecleaning

It's Eastertime, and that's when many seasonal homeowners do their spring house cleaning.

Coastline Volunteer Rescue Squad wants those castoffs for its annual Fourth of July weekend Trash & Treasure sale.

In previous years, donations have ranged from toasters to stoves and sofas, fans and heaters, toys and shoes.

The squad is a non-profit organization with an IRS tax-exempt number. It can give a receipt for the item's value as a tax donation.

Squad members ask, however, that the items donated be in reasonable working order and usable by the buyer.

To arrange for delivery of dona-

tions, contact Coastline at its emergency number, 842-2222; a member will call you back on another line. The squad can arrange to pick up bulky items.

Coastline is adding a four-stall shelter behind its present building on Holden Beach Road to house vehicles now outside and to free up space inside the current building for storage

of items such as medical supplies, training equipment and oxygen tanks.

The addition will house a crash scene truck with items such as a "Jaws Of Life" extrication tool, flood lights and a portable generator; and the squad's 16-foot power boat with dragging equipment; a back-up ambulance for when other units are in

use or undergoing repair. The fourth bay would be used as storage space or items for the Trash & Treasure sale, which is a major income-producer for the squad.

If the space could be provided, squad members are considering making the Trash and Treasure event a year-round sale.
