

# East Side Changes Name, Location

East Side Fellowship (formerly East Side Assembly) has moved to a new location.

As East Side Assembly the church, which will be three years old Christmas week, was formerly housed in the old Powell Funeral Home building in Shallotte. It relocated this week to the old UCB/Skippergraphics building at the corner of Main and Caroline streets.

The name change, said spokesman Sandy Pigott, is to clarify that the church is not affiliated with the Assemblies of God. Rather it is a nondenominational full-gospel church.

Its pastor, the Rev. Bobby Causey, and his wife, Jane, are both attending Carolina Bible College in Fayetteville. The assistant pastor, Dwight

Reaves, is studying for a bachelor's degree.

This Sunday, Dec. 4, the church celebrates Homecoming, with the 11 a.m. message by the pastor and the message during the 6 p.m. service to be brought by evangelist Ed Baldwin of Rockingham. Sunday School is at 10 a.m.

Baldwin will return as guest speaker for the evening service on Dec. 11, while evangelist Hank Francis of Fayetteville will speak at the 11 a.m. service.

The church presents its Christmas musical, "Meet Him At The Manger," by Dave Clark, on Sunday, Dec. 18, at 6 p.m. Susan Reaves will direct. The children will present the Christmas play, "The Shoemaker."

An active church outreach

ministry includes sponsorship of 22 children through the "Living Water Ministries" Adopt-A-Child Feeding Program in Guatemala, a local jail and prison ministry and the local distribution outlet for the Christian Broadcasting Network University's "Operation Blessing" program.

During December, the pastor will be joining Junior Totten, host of "Answer Ministries," in his prison ministry in West Virginia.

On Dec. 10 the church will host a public demonstration of CBN University's "Sing, Spell, Read and Write" program for those who want to improve their literacy skills. The phonics-based program has helped thousands of inner-city children learn to read, said Pigott.
