## Christmas Tree Proceeds Will Benefit 4-H

The Brunswick County Agricultural Extension Service again this year is selling Christmas trees to benefit the local 4-H youth program.

According to Associate Extension Agent Billy Privette, trees from the local agricultural office's demonstration plot at the county complex in Bolivia will be available on Tuesday,

Dec. 6, at 2 p.m.

Cost is \$25 per tree. The tax deductible contribution will go to the Brunswick County 4-H Development Fund. A drawing will be held Dec. 6 to distribute the trees to contributors.

The demonstration plot was planted about five years ago to encourage Christmas tree growing

locally. The plot now contains about 100 trees, mainly Virginia pines, white pines and red cedars.

Over the past four years, the project has raised at least \$1,000 each year for 4-H, Privette said. About 50 trees have been sold each year.

After the drawing is held, the trees will be cut by members of the agricultural office. However, individuals will be allowed to dig up their tree if they wish to keep it alive for transplanting later, he added.

Individuals who wish to buy one of the trees should contact the Brunswick County Agricultural Extension Service at 253-4425 or mail their name, address and telephone number to the extension office in Bolivia.
