Local Highway 17 Projects On Transportation Agenda

Adoption of the state's transportation improvement plan for the next eight years tops the list of items on the agenda when the N.C. Board of Transportation meets Dec. 9 in Raleigh.

The meeting begins at 9 a.m. in the Highway Building.

Speed-up of the four-laning of U.S. 17 from Supply to Winnabow is proposed in the draft Transportation Improvement Program.

Also on the board's agenda are requests that relate to preparations to

four-lane U.S. 17 between Grissettown and the South Carolina state line.

Sought are approval of 1) right of way and utilities on U.S. 17 from just west of N.C. 904 at Grissettown to just west of Old Shallotte Road (S.R. 1316), a distance of 5.4 miles, with an estimated cost of \$3.2 million; and 2) right of way and utilities on U.S. 17 from the South Carolina state line to eight-tenths of a mile west of N.C. 904, a distance of 6.1 miles, at an estimated cost of \$3.1 million.
