


#### Sail Away, Sail Away

## **Literacy Tutor Training** To Begin Sept. 7 At BCC

Adults interested in helping other adults learn to read and write can still sign up for a tutor training workshop that begins Sept. 7 at Brunswick Community College.

Sponsored by the Brunswick County Literacy Council, the Laubach Way To Reading workshop will meet for four consecutive Thursday nights at the Brunswick Interagency Building. Class hours are 6:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m., with a minimum of 10 contact hours required for certification.




Cost is \$15 except for students age 65 or older, who will not be charged.

Tutor training is offered by the Council four times a year, as a large pool of volunteers is needed in order to match students with tutors who live nearby and are available at suitable hours.

There is also a demand for new or reactivated tutors interested in working with individual students enrolled in Brunswick Community College's Adult Basic Education program at locations throughout the county.
