## **Control Thermostat For Ideal Climate**


An upcoming workshop sponsored by Brunswick Community College and Brunswick Electric Membership Corp. focus on indoor climate control.

The Brunswick County Sheriff's Department remained on the lookout Tuesday for two men suspected of assaulting an Ash area man March 11 outside the victim's residence.


