Lutheran Church Calls Pastor

Don R. Safrit of Salisbury has been selected as the new pastor of St. Luke Lutheran Church in Shallotte.

A minister at Christiana Evangelical Lutheran Church from 1977 until now, Safrit will begin his local ministry June 2. He will be accompanied by his wife, Theresa Lyerly Safrit.

A native of the China Grove area, he was graduated from China Grove High School and Lenoir-Rhyne College, where he received a B.A. in sociology. He earned his master of divinity in 1969.

Safrit's church and work experience includes a student church internship while at Lutheran Seminary in 1967-68, service to dual parishes of St. Peter's, Churchville, Va., and Redeemer, McKinley, Va., from 1969-1971. He then served Good Hope Lutheran Church in Hickory from 1971 to 1977, until going to Christiana.

According to a news release, he was active in helping to make that church "a positive involved force in community life in eastern Rowan County."
