

Shallotte Teen Pleads Guilty To Burning Of Woodlands

An Ash area teen-ager pleaded guilty in Brunswick County District Court last week to five counts of misdemeanor burning of woodlands.

Ronnie Simmons, 16, of Mill Branch Road, was given a two-year suspended sentence by Judge Jerry A. Jolly, who consolidated the charges for sentencing.

Simmons was charged by the N.C. Forestry Service for intentionally setting fire on April 4 to woodland belonging to Federal Paper Co., according to the warrants filed at the Brunswick County Clerk of Court's office.

Jolly placed Simmons on two years' unsupervised probation, ordered that he pay \$137.30 in restitution to the Forestry Service and to not violate any laws for two years.

Simmons was also ordered not to go on the property of Federal Paper for two years without permission and to perform 48 hours of community service.
