Driver Who Drove Stolen Truck Through Checkpoint Sentenced

A Holden Beach area man who drove through a highway drug checkpoint in May with a stolen truck was sentenced in Brunswick County District Court last week.

Orville Earl Reeves, 33, pleaded guilty to speeding 100 mph in a 55 mph zone, driving with no license, failing to wear a seatbelt, speeding to elude arrest, misdemeanor possession of stolen goods and injury to real property.

Reeves was charged May 10 by Trooper J.W. Brooks of the State Highway Patrol after Reeves failed to stop at a checkpoint in Leland, leading officers on a high-speed chase that ended in the Old Towne subdivision.

Reeves drove through an 80-foot section of chainlink fence and then tried to drive between a truck and a tree in Old Towne, said Lt. David Crocker, of the Brunswick County Sheriff's Department.

The 1989 Ford truck Reeves was driving had Michigan tags and was reported stolen from there. Crocker said. The truck was destroyed.

Judge David G. Wall sentenced Reeves to two years in prison, suspended for three years and placed him on three years' supervised probation. He was also given a fourweek active sentence to be served in the Brunswick County Jail.

Reeves was credited for 18 days served, fined \$500 and ordered to pay the following restitutions: \$2,816 for damages, \$700 to the N.C. Department of Transportation and \$35 to the Brunswick County Sheriff's Department. He must also pay \$250 in attorney fees and was ordered not to operate a motor vehicle until he obtains a valid license.
