Topics include foodborne illness, importance of time and temperature in safe food and cleaning and sani-



Sanitation grades for restaurants and food or drink stands are based on a system of scoring where an "A" is given to scores of 90 percent or better; a "B" to scores of at least 80 percent and less than 90 percent; a "C" to scores of at least 70 percent and less than 80 percent. The permit would be revoked for any establishment that receives a score of less than 70 percent.





Construction Climbs

Permits for more than \$2.5 million in construction were issued by the Brunswick County Building Inspection Department in July.

Inspectors issued 296 permits for seven signs, \$23,632. \$2,521,291 in total value, according to the monthly report. Of those permits, 129 were for buildings, 122 for electrical, 10 for plumbing and 35 for mechanical inspections.

Seven single-family permits were issued for \$479,939 in value. Also, 83 mobile home permits were given along with six commercial building permits for \$1,846,600 in value.

Other permits were as follows:

one remodeling, \$27,036; six additions, \$48,394; four garages, \$64,110; five decks and porches, \$14,220; three pools, \$17,360; and

For the year, 2,484 permits have been issued, 91 for single-family homes valued at \$6 million and 33 commercial permits for \$8.8 million

Total value of new construction this year stands at \$16.7 million.

In July 1990, permits totaled \$11,914 for the month and \$104,933 for the year.
