## Hope Harbor Awarded Crime Victims Grant

Hope Harbor Home, Brunswick County's shelter for victims of domestic violence, has been awarded an \$11,806 grant through the Governor's Crime Commission.

The award is part of \$7.48 million in federal grants distributed to drug enforcement, juvenile justice and delinquency prevention, and crime victims programs statewide, said Joe Dean, secretary of the Department of Crime Control and Public Safety.

Hope Harbor is the only Brunswick County government or social service agency to receive one of the 1991 grants awarded in the three areas: victims of crimes, drug control and system improvement and juvenile justice and delinquency prevention.

This Victims of Crime Act grant required a 20 percent local match and is for the period April 1, 1991, through June 30, 1992.

Three New Hanover County/Wilmington programs received grants totaling \$90,190, while three programs in Pender County received grants totaling \$260,000.
