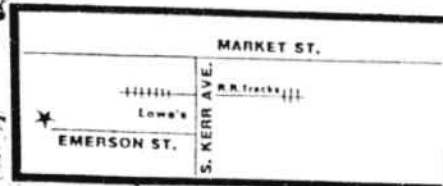


**Coastline Gives Ambulance**

**Park Didn't Sample, Didn't Tell Public**

Mayfair Mobile Home Park in Brunswick County failed to notify the public that it did not properly sample or monitor water for coliform bacteria, reports a state agency.

The N.D. Division of Environmental Health said the owner/operator of Mayfair Park did not properly sample or monitor water during May 1991.

Under the North Carolina Drinking Water Act the owner/operator of a public water system which has incurred a sampling or monitoring violation must publish information about that violation in a daily newspaper which serves the area within 90 days of the sampling failure. It then must notify the state division. Otherwise, the state department must notify area media.
