

Ash Man Charged With Shooting Into Occupied Mobile Home

An Ash man was arrested Sunday after he allegedly fired several shots into a mobile home occupied by three men.

Joe Russell Vereen, 32, of Route 1, was charged by Brunswick County Sheriff's Detective Don Stovall with discharging a firearm into occupied property.

According to Deputy J.R. Earp Jr.'s report, the incident happened on Little Prong Road (S.R. 1336) around 4:15 a.m.

The resident accused Vereen of coming to his home where the men apparently got into an argument, Earp reported.

After the homeowner began closing the door, Vereen allegedly opened fire into the home with a .22-caliber rifle. No one was injured in the incident, said Stovall.

In other reports on file at the sheriff's department:

■ Someone fired two shots at a Leland man's car as he was driving on N.C. 133 near Belville. The man had received a threatening phone call earlier Saturday, indicating that "his time was marked," reported Deputy Pete Moore.

When asked what the caller meant by the statement, the response was, "You will see later," the victim reported.

The shooting occurred around 8:45 p.m. when a vehicle came up beside the victim's and fired two shots, missing the car, Moore said.

■ A Winnabow woman believes her brother may have taken \$700 from her purse and \$800 from her home to buy a plane ticket to New York, reported Sgt. Charlie Miller. The woman's car was found abandoned at the Motel 6 in Wilmington. An airport parking lot ticket was found inside the car, Miller reported.

■ Two men were seen running from a home that had been broken into at Little Shallotte River Estates Saturday, reported Sgt. Gene Browning. Taken were \$250 in appliances and a \$100 cable television box. Damage was \$300.

■ Items worth \$3,275 were taken from the Kicking Mule Beverage Barn in Leland Friday. Missing are 207 cartons of cigarettes, 42 cases of beer, three cases of cooking oil and five boxes of candy bars, reported Deputy William Hewett.

■ A gun found in the back seat of a woman's car in Leland had been reported stolen from her son's Baldwin Estates home last Wednesday, Nov. 27, reported Deputy Steve Mason. The .22-caliber revolver was wrapped in a T-shirt and had been fired.

■ Thieves took a \$2,500 two-way radio from a W.E. Blackmon Construction Co. truck on Navassa Road between Nov. 22-27, reported Moore. Damage was \$30.

■ A video recorder and jewelry were stolen from a home on U.S. 74-76 near Maco last Wednesday, reported Moore. Two suspects were seen leaving the home around 2:30 p.m.

■ Thieves took \$2,850 in jewelry and caused \$75 in damage during a break-in at a home on Old Mill Road in Leland between Nov. 24-26, reported Deputy William Hewett.

■ A front door was forced open at a home on Old Georgetown Road between July 4 and Nov. 28, reported Deputy Darryl Marlow. A television and microwave worth \$1,250 were taken. Damage was \$500.

■ A woman told Deputy Brian Sanders that she saw her Leland High School class ring for sale at the Easy Pawn Shop in Leland Saturday. She told Sanders that she was going to take out warrants against another woman suspected of stealing the ring, valued at \$300.

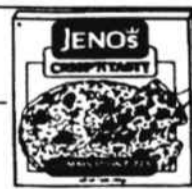
