Ash Man Charged With Shooting Into Occupied Mobile Home

An Ash man was arrested Sunday after he allegedly fired several shots into a mobile home occupied by three men.

Joe Russell Vereen, 32, of Route 1. was charged by Brunswick County Sheriff's Detective Don Stovall with discharging a firearm into occupied property.

According to Deputy J.R. Earp Jr.'s report, the incident happened on Little Prong Road (S.R. 1336) around 4:15 a.m.

The resident accused Vereen of coming to his home where the men apparently got into an argument, Earp reported.

After the homeowner began closing the door. Vereen allegedly opened fire into the home with a 22-caliber rifle. No one was injured in the incident, said Stovall.

The shooting occurred around 8:45 p.m. when a vehicle came up beside the victim's and fired two shots, missing the car, Moore said.
