c. The exterior siding consists predominantly of vinyl or aluminum horizontal lap siding (whose reflectivity does not exceed that of gloss white paint), wood or hardboard, comparable in composition, appearance and durability to the exterior siding commonly used in standard residential construction.
d. The manufactured home is set up in accordance with the standards set by the North Carolina Department of Insurance and a continuous masonry, vinyl, aluminum or wood curtain wall, unpierced except for required ventilation and access is installed under the perimeter of the Manufactured Home.
e. The moving hitch, wheels and axles, transportation lights have been removed.
f. Manufactured home to meet the requirements of wind zone 2.
