

Judge Jolly Sentences 13 On DWI Charges In One-Day Session

Brunswick County District Court Judge Jerry A. Jolly sentenced 13 people on driving while impaired charges during a busy day in court last Thursday, Jan. 2, in Bolivia.

The holiday season has limited the Brunswick County District Court schedule to just one day over the past two weeks. The normal three-day District Court schedule was to resume this week.

On the docket last Thursday were 306 items, including a number of DWI cases. Judge Jolly issued 10 active sentences from those DWI charges.

Four DWI defendants were ordered to spend seven days in jail, and three were sentenced to 14 days in jail. Another six defendants received suspended sentences after they were found guilty of DWI.
