West Girls Beat Vikings, Scorpions

The West Brunswick girls' basketball team extended its winning streak to four games last week with victories over North Brunswick and West Columbus.

The Lady Trojans routed North Brunswick 66-29 Friday night in Leland after cruising to a 63-45 home win against the Lady Vikings last Tuesday.

West Brunswick (10-2, 17-4) entered the final week of the regular season tied with Whiteville for second place in the Waccamaw 2-A Conference.

The Lady Trojans were to host East Bladen Tuesday night before traveling to Boiling Spring Lakes Friday for the season finale against South Brunswick.

North Brunswick

On Friday, Christy King scored 14 points and Nicole Norris added 13 to lead West Brunswick to its 37-point win at North Brunswick.

The Lady Trojans led the entire game, jumping out to a 10-0 lead in the first 3:20 and leading 16-6 after

one quarter.

West Brunswick used a 10-1 run in the first half of the second period to take a 26-7 lead.

Leading 34-15 at halftime, the Lady Trojans outscored the Lady Scorpions 21-6 in the third quarter to take a 55-21 advantage into the fourth quarter.

Catherine Bell, Stacey Hill and Amber Mercer scored eight points each for West Brunswick.

LaTanya Grady led North Brunswick with 10 points and Tasha Robbins added eight for the Lady Scorpions.

Wolfpack Blows Away Scorpions

Lamont Smith scored a game-high 17 points to lead host Whiteville to an 85-44 thrashing of North Brunswick last Tuesday night.

Coupled with a 59-58 home loss to West Brunswick on Friday, the Scorpions fell to 1-11 in the Waccamaw 2-A Conference and 5-13 overall.

North Brunswick was to finish the regular season slate with a road game against South Robeson Tuesday night.

The Scorpions host the undefeated Fairmont Golden Tornadoes in the season finale Friday night.

The Wolfpack, which lost at North Brunswick on Jan. 21, got revenge last Tuesday as four players scored in double figures.
